***Notes on Overall General Excellence Winners**

1. Overall winners were determined by the final point totals earned by each yearbook. Books earned points based on how they placed in each individual category:
 - First place in a category = 5 points
 - Second place in a category = 4 points
 - Third place in a category = 3 points
 - Honorable mention in a category = 1 point
2. The three books with the highest scores in each division received first, second and third place for Overall General Excellence in their respective divisions.
3. Other books in each division received honorable mention if their final point totals finished 12 points or fewer behind the point total of the third-place book in their division.
4. Honorable mention winners are listed alphabetically by school name.
